

**MEMORANDUM**

 Re: 2022-2023 Student Withdrawals from IMSA  
 Date: July 14, 2023

From July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, 19 students withdrew from the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy. This number is lower than the number of students who withdrew between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022, which was 32 students.

Details regarding the 19 students who withdrew between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023 are included below for your reference:

To summarize the chart above detailing the 19 students who withdrew from IMSA from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023:

- 11 female and 8 male students withdrew
- Seven White students, six Hispanic or Latino students, three Asian students, two Black or African American students, and one Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander student
- Three seniors, 10 juniors, and six sophomores

In addition to the 19 students who withdrew from the Academy between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023, seven students were also dismissed for academic or behavioral reasons: three females and four males; three Asian students, two White students, one Hispanic or Latino student, and one Black or African American student.

By comparison, the following is a summary of the 32 students who withdrew during the prior academic year, between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022:

- 18 female and 14 male students withdrew
- 22 White students, four Black or African American students, three Hispanic or Latino students, two students who identify as Two or More Races, and one Asian student
- Four seniors, eight juniors, and 20 sophomores

In addition to the 32 students who withdrew from the Academy between July 1, 2021 and June 30, 2022, 17 students were also dismissed for academic reasons: nine females and eight males; 10 Black or African American, three Hispanic or Latino, three White, and one Asian.
