Thank you for writing to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy (IMSA) with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

On Feb 10, 2025*, you requested the following records:

- Number of students contacted in any way, even indirectly, after identification via the ISBE datashare in 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 cycles.
- Sample mailing or redacted mailing rendered in 2024-2025 cycle to students contacted after being identified via the ISBE datashare.
- 3. Any breakdown of contacts for 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 with respect to the four demographic categories of the datashare (Black, Latino/Hispanic, low income, rural).
